2015 LEGISLATOR SCORES - Legislative leadership is more than just taking votes, which is why we're including evaluations on priority gun responsibility legislation, bill sponsorship, and legislative and community advocacy.

VOTES AND SPONSORSHIPS - Sponsored and voted on bills to increase community safety and responsibility - this includes sponsoring or voting for bills which increase safety and against bills which move our state in the wrong direction.

VOTES SCORED INCLUDE:

- SB 5381 - Sheena Henderson's Law (support)
- SB 5269 - Joel's Law (support)
- HB 1448 - Response to Suicide Threats (support)
- HB 1857 - Extreme Risk Protection Orders (support)
- SBs 5579, 5615, 5539 - Reopening our state's background check loophole by creating exemptions to Initiative 594 (oppose)

LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY - Points (positive and negative) reflect the degree to which legislators advocated for gun responsibility in committee, amongst colleagues, on the floor, and in Caucus.

COMMUNITY ADVOCACY - Scores reflect how deeply legislators engaged with constituents, community groups and Alliance for Gun Responsibility partners to work towards greater gun responsibility.

★ = Legislators who went the extra mile for gun safety, from meeting with constituents to speaking out in the press.
